FEAL's calendar of regular events aims to connect fund executives with the most up-to-date industry thinking in a friendly and collaborative environment.

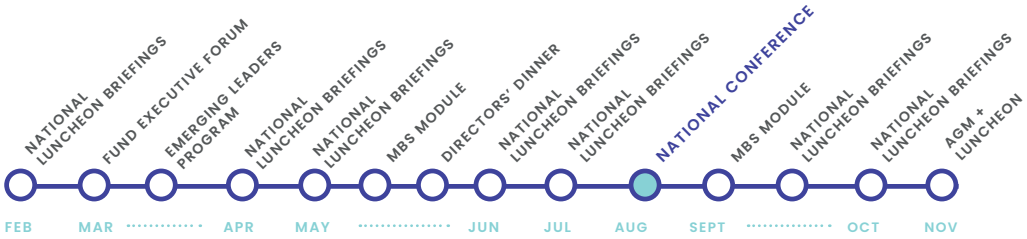

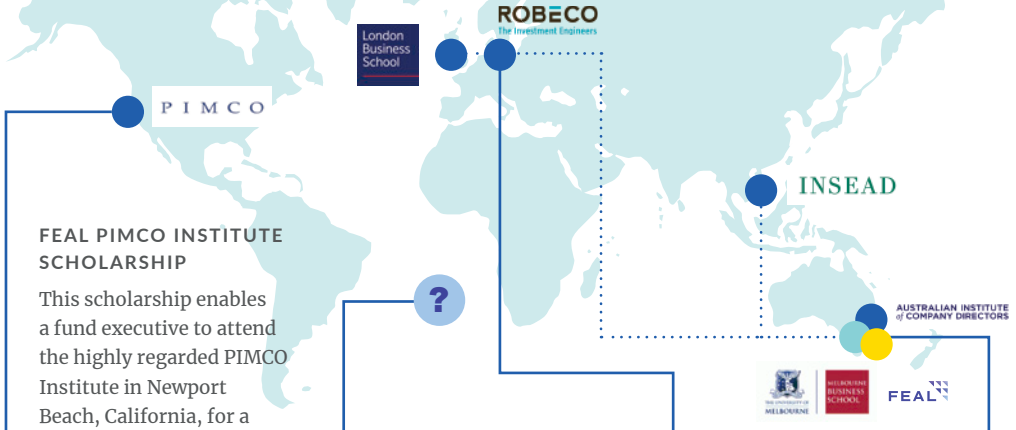


FEAL MENTORING INITIATIVE

FEAL PIMCO INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship enables a fund executive to attend the highly regarded PIMCO Institute in Newport Beach, California, for a three-day residential course focussing on investment issues and risk management.

EMERGING LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP - MELBOURNE BUSINESS SCHOOL

A scholarship is available for the Emerging Leaders Program, a five day residential program designed to provide senior managers the opportunity to develop their leadership skills.

A scholarship opportunity is available to attend each of the twelve modules offered as part of the FEAL Melbourne Business School Masters Program. This includes international scholarship opportunities to attend program modules delivered at London Business School and INSEAD Singapore

FEAL INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

This Scholarship is designed specifically for current and aspiring fund Chief Investment Officers. Recognising their roles as business leaders in their own right, the scholarship provides a senior investment professional with the opportunity to develop skills in a general management discipline at an international business school, of their choice.

FEAL ROBECO EXECUTIVE SCHOLARSHIP

The Robeco Executive Scholarship enables the recipient to travel to Rotterdam, The Netherlands and visit Robeco's head office to join the Robeco Investment Leadership Program.

FEAL MICHAEL DWYER LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship enables a senior fund executive to attend the Cranlana Colloquium programme for aspiring leaders. The scholarship includes the one week course (including accommodation) to study ethical leadership.

FEAL AICD SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship enables a fund executive to attend the Company Directors Course offered by the Australian Institute of Company Directors.

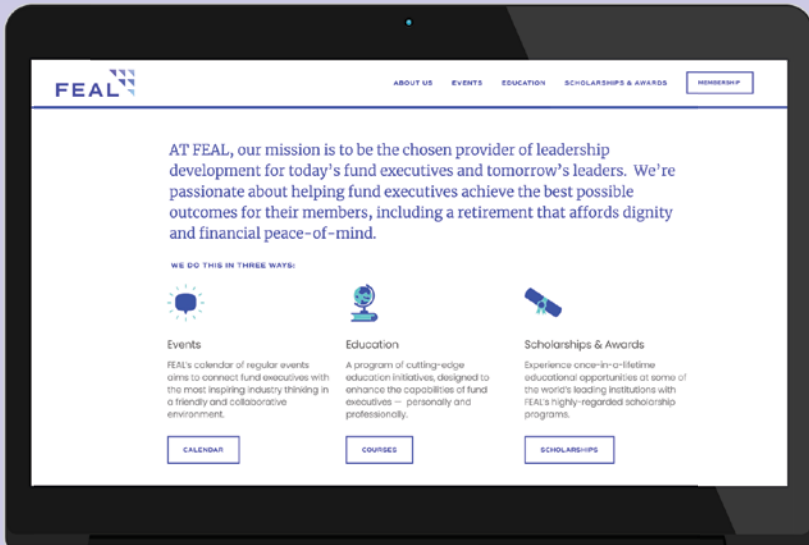
